THE CITY RING ROAD

One-way urban and suburban road network designed to provide for smooth transit operation in and out of the city.

The project is well under way with a lot of benefits already in place. It is financed with the assistance of the Saudi Fund for Development.

FOOTBALL TRAINING CENTER N/FS BIH

[4] DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES SINCE 2005



The project launched in March 2011 at the Crkvice Hill, Zenica. It is an 8.5 million KM worth project financed by UEFA (7.6 million KM) and FIFA (900,000 KM).

The land of 29,000 m² is provided by the local government. The compound will include a stadium, stands for 1,500 spectators, a 24-room and 2-apartment



hotel including restaurants and a number of other facilities needed for proper coaching of all national teams.

The project will include the reconstruction of the 500 m long access road and a parking lot for 60 vehicles.

STRAY ANIMAL SHELTER

Stray animals deserve to be provided a proper shelter where they could be kept, fed and made available for adoption. In collaboration with the UNDP, the local government has made steps to build the animal shelter. The project design is already made, a location found and what's left is to obtain all required permits and approvals. It is the 4,000 m² facility that could accommodate 100 dogs, including outdoor and indoor sections and staff offices. The Center is to be located near the village of Stranjani to effectively displace the stray animals from the city streets.

WASTE DEPOT CLOSURE AND LANDSLIDE REHABILITATION

With the new modern landfill in operation, the old waste depot needs to be closed. In collaboration with Piedmont Region (Italy) and "ERIS" Water Institute (Sardinia, Italy), we have made a depot rehab study. It includes all works that need to be done to comply with the EU regulations and environment standards. The landslides that occurred as a result of the improper waste disposal activities need a special attention. It is of utmost importance to stabilize the land and resolve the landslide issue before the area is covered with the top soil and landscaped.



INDUSTRIAL WASTE DEPOT REHABILITATION



The industrial waste from the Steelworks has been deposited for years at the "Rača" depot. This is the 66.5 ha area taken over by the local government in order to make it available for legal reprocessing of the recyclable material and total rehabilitation and landscaping of the area.

To do that, we have engaged the MLM Group Zagreb as a strategic partner for the industrial waste removal and site rehabilitation. In addition to environmental improvements, the local government expects to receive some financial benefits from this project.

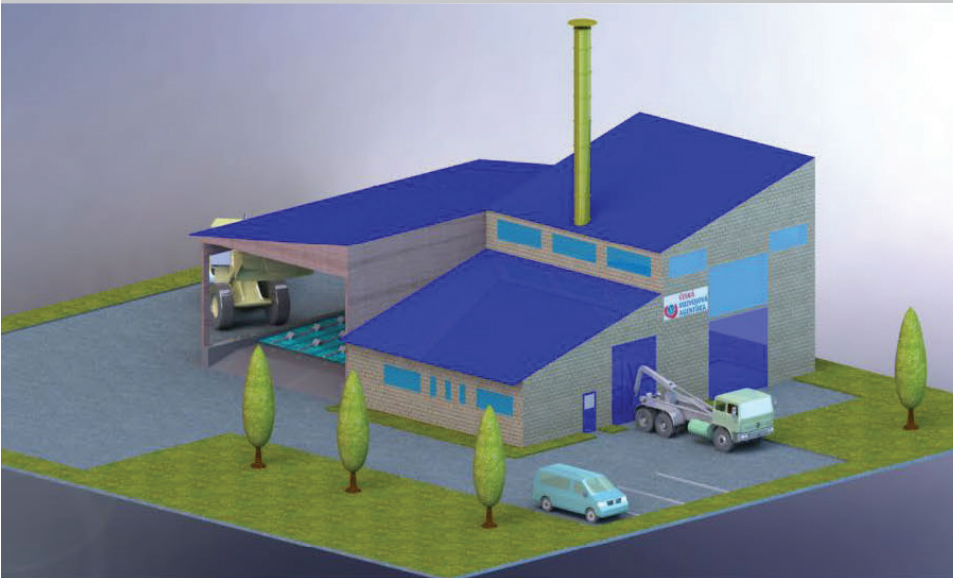

BIOMASS-FIRED HEATING FACILITY IN NEMILA, ZENICA

The local government signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Czech Development Agency in July 2011 to implement the Nemila neighborhood district heating project as part of the renewable resources usage scheme in the Municipality. It is a biomass-fired facility including all infrastructural systems to be finished in 2013.

The Czech Government approved a grant of 1.48 million EUR to finance the project. It is a 3 MW heating facility that will provide heating to a local school, police station, outpatient

unit, community center and residential houses located along the heating pipe network. The project is about to be extended pending approval of the Czech Government.



COMBINED-CYCLE POWER PLANT

Gas-fired power plant project designed to offer a quality source of heat for district heating system and electricity generation was launched on April 20, 2011.

All required permits and papers are obtained, with construction works to start in the spring 2013.

The facility is to be run by a joint venture „KTG ZENICA“ composed of KTG AG Lugano

– 75% share and Municipality of Zenica – 25%

This gas-fired facility will eliminate the air pollution currently generated from burning of 700 tones of brown coal a day at the obsolete district heating boiler facility.

The CCPP capacity: 390 MW Electricity / 170 MW Heat.

Estimated costs: 500 million KM.

Many of these projects have already been implemented.



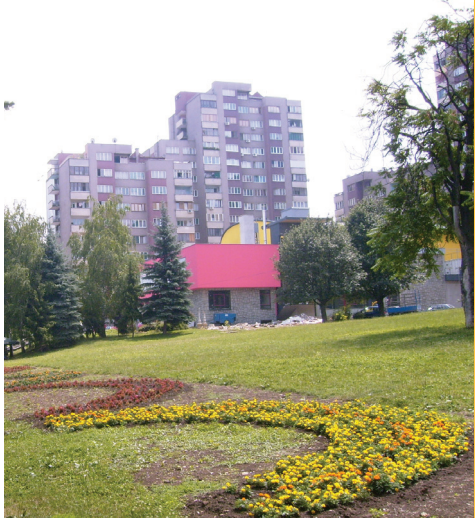

INDUSTRIAL PARK ZENICA 1

Industrial Park designed to foster local economic development (LED).

It is aimed at diversification of Zenica economy previously based on metal processing only. It is built on a piece of land that used to be run by the Zenica Steelworks in the past

Total area: 336,427 m²

It is well connected to the road and railway infrastructure in the city and wider region. The Park accommodates a number of new small and medium-sized companies.

A home to new modern technology start-ups engaged in development of new technologies and new ideas for more sophisticated products.

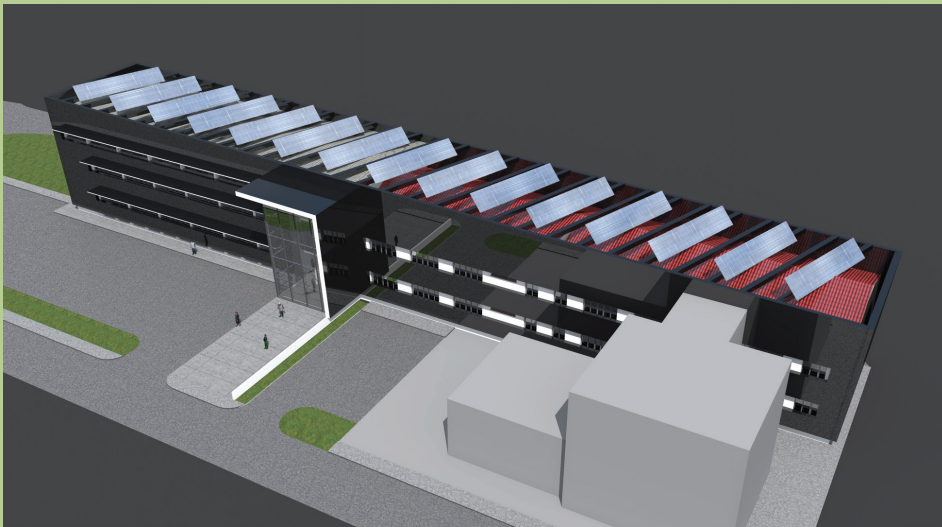
Run by ZEDA – Zenica Local Development Agency.

PRIMARY HEALTH CARE



The city government has rehabilitated 17 community centers in different parts of the municipality to serve the daily needs of the local population. Eleven outpatient units rehabilitated by the Zenica Health Center, local people and Federal Ministry of Health. The outpatient unit in the village of Moščanica fully financed by the city government in the amount of 213,000 KM.





SCHOOL AND KINDERGARTENS



Several primary schools fully rehabilitated.
Student commuting costs of 250,000 KM fully covered by the local government
Students' scholarship for outstanding students in the annual amount of 30,000 KM
A number of kindergarten buildings have been rehabilitated.

WAR-TORN BUILDINGS – KANAL 92 NGO



30 families were left homeless as a result of air raids during the aggression on BiH.

They formed a KANAL 92 NGO in order to have their housing issues resolved.

The five-story building worth 1.2 million KM was built to accommodate those families.

The project is financed by the Federal Ministry of Refugees, Ministry of Labor and Social Politics of ZE-DO Canton and Zenica Steelworks

BLUE WATER PROJECT

In order to provide for a quality source of drinking water for the forthcoming century, a joint water supply project is being implemented in collaboration with the municipalities of Travnik, Novi Travnik, Vitez and Busovača.

It is the Plava voda (Blue water) project designed to bring drinking water from Plava voda source to these municipalities.

It is a 33 km long water pipe line that would bring additional 400 l/s to Zenica and its citizens



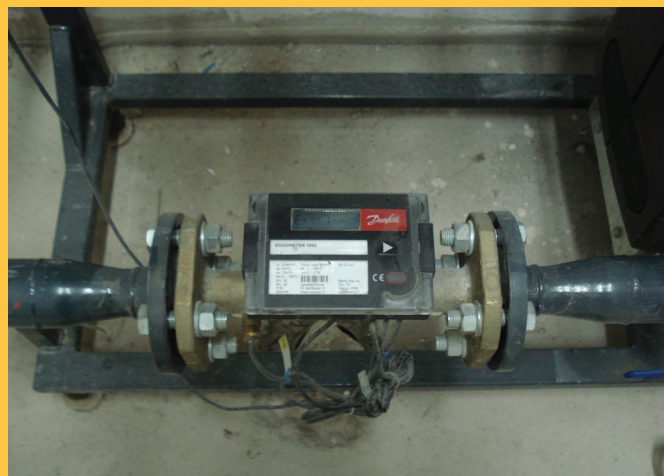

DALJINSKO GRIJANJE GRADA ZENICE

The GOC "Grijanje" Company is going to continue improving the district heating network to provide for enhanced efficiency and safety of the system.

These activities are aimed at reduction of primary piping leakages, extension of network to include larger consumers, reduction of air pollution and installation of the centralized supervision and control system.
